EYFS for Playworkers

The EYFS strategy affects children from birth to 31st August following their 5th Birthday, it will be relevant to you if you have children registered in your setting that fall into that age range. It's an interesting way to review what we're already doing within our settings, and this is the thing; there isn't anything in the pack or guidance that will be unfamiliar to you. If, as settings and practitioners, you're already working towards the Playwork Principles, Values and Assumptions and meeting the Best Play Objectives, then you are already doing what the EYFS expects of you. If you are regularly reflecting on your practice, you will also be doing much of what is required.
